**Learner qualifying criteria**

- Funding is available to financially disadvantaged learners (combined household income below R1 million rand)
- Learners must **NOT** be receiving **any other government funding** for the same academic year.
- Must be **South African Citizens**.
- **ONLY 1<sup>st</sup> year students** studying services sector degrees

In the meantime, prepare the following documents that will be required with your completed forms:

- **Affidavit declaring UNEMPLOYMENT**, stamped by commissioner of oath
- **CLEAR Certified ID Copy (Not older than 3 Months)** both sides of the card
- **CLEAR Certified Matric Results** not older than 3 months
- Proof of registration for 2026 academic year
- Fee Statement for 2026 academic year
- **Both parents CLEAR certified ID copies** and **Proof of income (Payslips)**, if parents are deceased attach death certificate, if unemployed, attach labour letter, affidavit and ITA34 SARS document.
